Important: Please see the General Regulations and Entry Specification Section in the beginning of this Omnibus for additional policies that this show subscribes to and follows.

Class Fees: Intro/Group: \$18.00; Training: \$20.00; First and above: \$25.00.
Camper or RV: \$25 per night for camper hook-ups. \$15 per night for tent camping. Pick up a permit in the show office at check-in.
Office Charge: \$15 per horse/rider combination. Horses will be given a separate number for the schooling show.
Payment: Entries accepted by mail; check must accompany entry. No credit cards accepted; no entries accepted by fax or email until original entry and check arrive by mail.
Late Entries: \$20 late fee for entries received after the closing date. After the schedule is complete, horses already entered in the show may switch or add classes with an additional \$5 per class fee if scheduling allows the changes.
Concessions: Concession stand on grounds during show hours.
Stabling/Tack Fees: \$80 for stall from Thur-Sun; \$70 for stall from Fri-Sun per horse. All horses must be stabled. \$50 for a weekend tack stall; \$40 per day for either a horse or a tack stall. Stall days are 24 hour periods defined as follows: 3 PM Thurs - 3 PM Fri; 3 PM Fri - 3 PM Sat or 3 PM Sat - 3 PM Sun. Horses allowed on grounds after 12 noon on Thursday, July 10, 2008.
Bedding: **No bedding provided.** Bags may be ordered on the entry form or from the show office while supplies last for \$6/bag. Special requests filled on a first come, first serve basis.
Non-competing horse: \$25 for horses on grounds but not competing; Must fill out entry form for number and pay stabling and office fees.

Refunds, Confirmations/Times, Accomodations: As per the recognized show. All classes in a standard size arena.

Awards: Ribbons to sixth place in all classes. Champion high point will also be awarded at appropriate divisions and levels. Classes with 10 or more entries will be pinned by division; trophies given for divisions with 3 or more riders; riders may only enter one division per class. Management reserves the right to combine or split classes due to the number of entries.

Mystery Test: Reader provided; state level on entry form; tests from past years!
